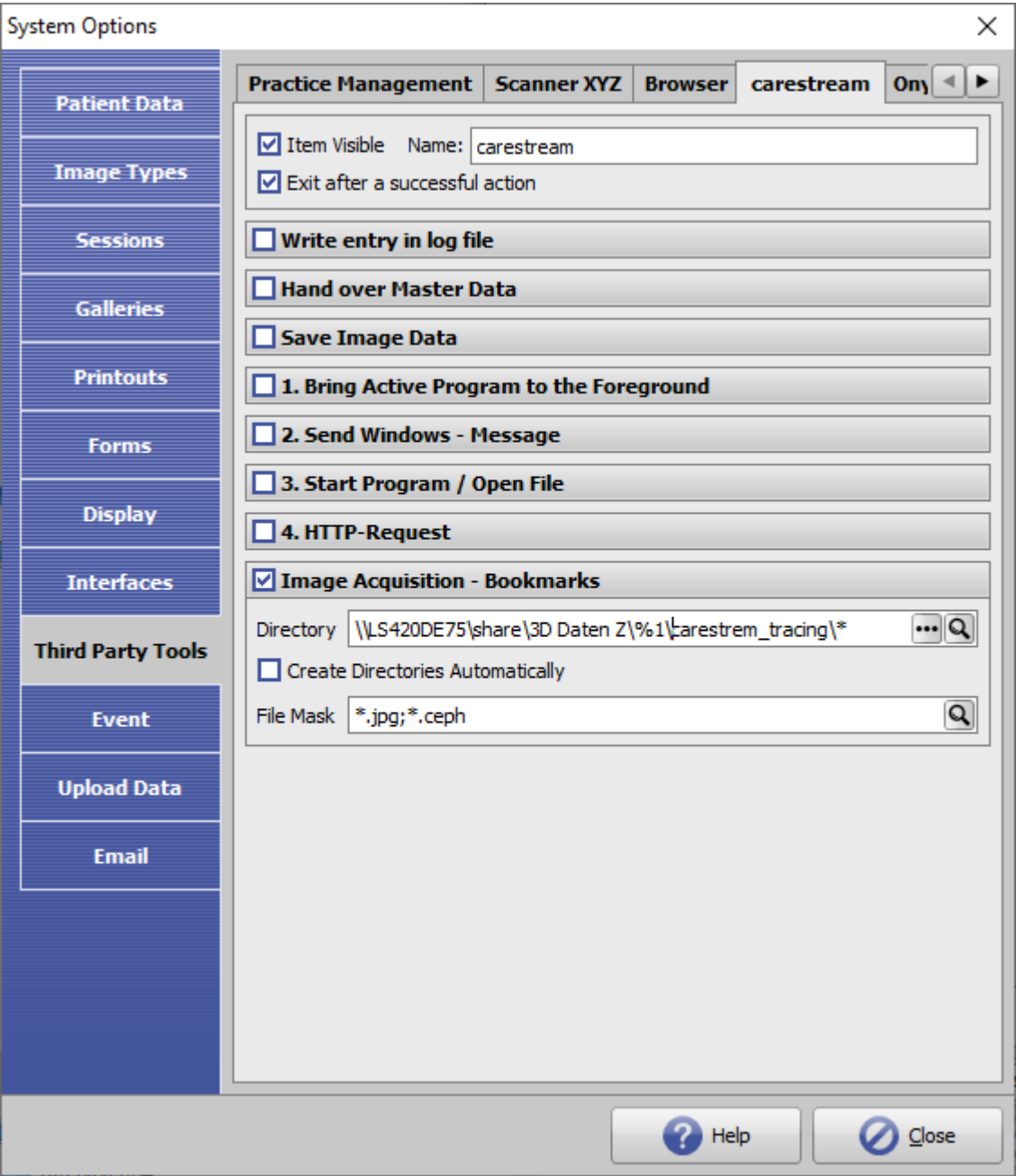


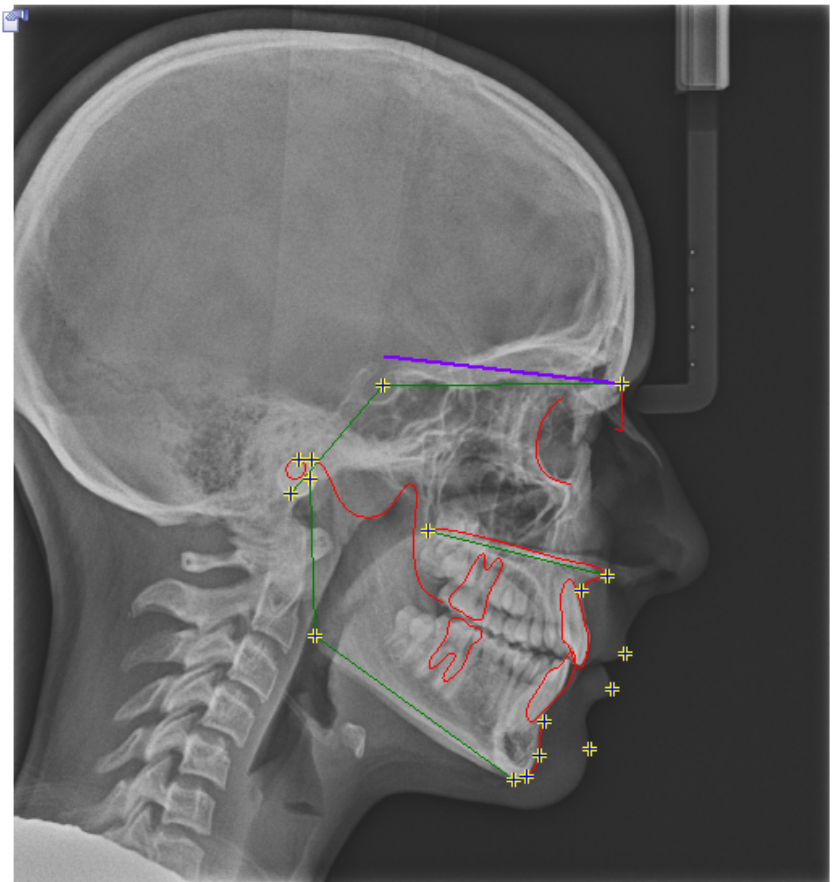
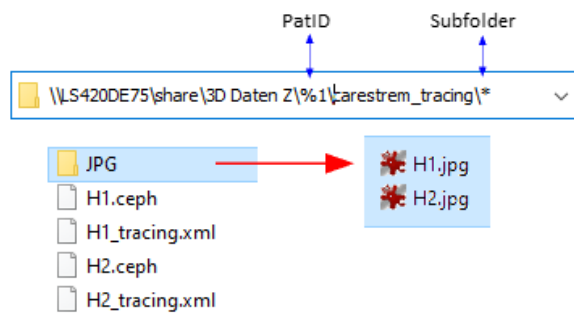
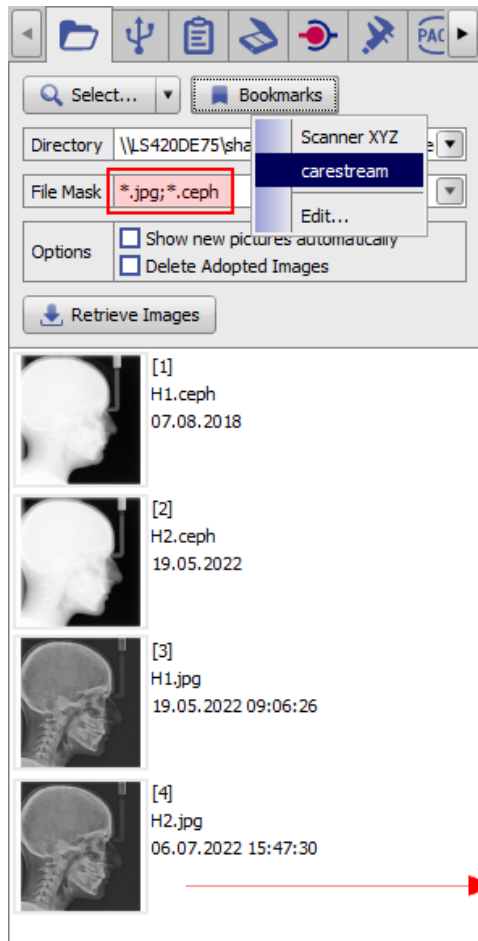
# Import Carestream Landmarks

Carestream Dental Imaging offers option [Autotracing] for acquired lateral ceph images, which can be used to automatically find certain reference points.

If this option is activated, a file H\*\_tracing.xml with the reference point information is stored side-by-side to the original image H\*.ceph in the predefined patient image folder and can be taken over to OnyxCeph<sup>3</sup>™ in parallel to the import of the lateral ceph converted by Carestream 8Bit stored in subfolder ../JPG.

If the Carestream images are imported via predefined bookmarks ([simple image import interface](#)), the file format \*.ceph must be allowed in addition to the \*.jpg format when using file masks in order to allow finding the XML tracing file associated with the lateral ceph.
